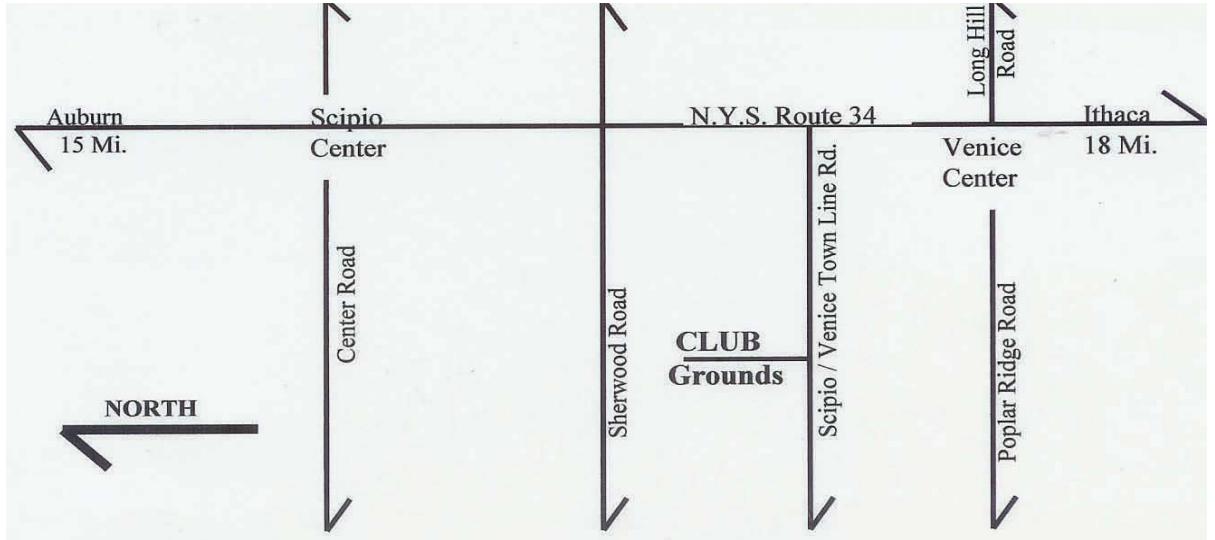

# Salmon Creek Sportsmen's Club, Inc.

**We Offer:** Skeet, 2 Trap Fields, 16 to 27 yard. Rifle Range of 150 yards and a covered Pistol Range. A new "WOBBLE Trap" was installed in 2003. As in Trap, targets move side to side, with the Wobble machine it also moves Up & Down, from 5° Low to 40° High. A great change from the average Trap Game. Our Five (5) Stand has a total of 9 traps involved in the 25 bird menu. The Five Stand (not much walking involved) offers a wide variety of targets, Incommers, Crossers, Teal, Chandelles and Rabbits. The Sporting Clays course with a 50 bird menu, 20 plus stations, many with multiple stands which simulates hunting in the natural surroundings of Hills, Gullies and Fields. The Club provides the Beginner to the Pro a full spectrum of Regular, Midi, Mini, Battue and Rabbit targets that really add up to some great shooting fun with incommers, tough crossing targets, high overhead flyers from a 40' Tower and jumping Rabbits. We try to make weekly changes to both our Sporting Clays and Five (5) Stand courses. The Five (5) Stand or Wobble Trap makes a perfect spot for a quick Warm-up prior to going out to the Sporting Clays course. A Sporting Clays course of 100 Birds is also available for special groups of shooters and arrangements can be made at the Club House.

**Here are some of the many Sporting Clay Fields at SALMON CREEK:**

## **"MOTIVATED RABBITS"**

On the ground, but Fast and High Jumpers through the Trees and Brush.

## **"TRAPPERS CHOICE"**

7 Timed Birds; singles, following pairs or doubles, our choice and threaded through trees or brush are tough, but a Fun Shoot.

## **"OVER SALMON"**

Right to Left targets that curl (curve) as they pass over Salmon Creek.

## **"SPRINGING TEAL"**

High Climbers, straight-up singles, following pairs or doubles. It gets harder with the Midi or Mini targets.

## **"DUCK BLIND"**

An original Duck Blind, Decoys & Boat from Cayuga Lake. You get to shoot targets like the Ducks that passed by the Blind in the early 70's. High Floaters that drop in from a 40' Tower, right in front of gunner. Looks easy but hang on.

## **"SNIPE in the WOODS"**

2 alleys in brush / trees, with following pairs and doubles, High and Low birds.

## **"FLURRY SHOOT"**

Multiple birds, up to 3 or 4 midi or mini's with a Poison Bird. Fast but Fun.

## **"HIGH OVERHEADS"**

Targets launched from "Hogs Back Ridge", a 30 foot high ridge with multiple stations located at it's base, easy but real tough.

## **"FUR and FEATHER"**

A bounding "Bunny", a climbing Chandelle" and a "Streaking" right to left Target makes for a Fun shoot with Multiple Targets. A "Gravity Rabbit" at 25' in front of you simple, yes, but watch how many are missed.

## **"NESTING CROWS"**

Curling Hi/Low, standard or midi birds that drop into the bush like nesting Crows.

## **"SALMON CREEK WOODIES"**

Shot from "Hogs Back Ridge" birds travel 2 alleys. In (low over the creek), & Out (over the grass). Quick shooting, but fun.

**Our Club House** offers some of the best food you will find in any of our area Gun Clubs. Breakfast served every Sunday, 8 AM till 11AM. Lunch served during all of our League or Tournament Shoots.

For those who need assistance getting around the Sporting Clay Course, in most cases a Members Golf Cart is around for your use. Carts are unable to get to all shooting stations so there is a bit of walking required to shoot the full course. We also stock Shotgun Shells for 12 & 20 ga guns as well as some Ammo Bags and shooting accessories.

NSCA Certified Shooting Instructor is also available for individual or group Instruction. For information, check at desk.

Youths under the age of 16 shoot for 1/2 price at Salmon Creek, but **MUST be accompanied by an Adult.**
